Year Two's topic for this half term is...

## Yo! Ho! Ho!



### **Your child will be learning about ...**

- using world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries;
- countries, continents and oceans;
- using simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language [for example, near and far; left and right], to describe the location of features and routes on a map;
- using aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features;
- devising a simple map and using and constructing basic symbols in a key.

### **In English this half term, the majority of children will be learning to...**

- predict what comes next in stories based on what has already happened
- to continue to learn the grammar aspects linked to Year 2 including: commas in lists, contractions and possessive apostrophes;
- to start to join handwriting

### **In Maths this half term, the majority of your child's class will be learning ...**

- how to use and solve problems with larger numbers to 1000;
- how to solve investigations and problems involving shape and symmetry;
- to use positional language;
- to know about weight and capacity;
- to learn the language of time and tell time to the nearest 5 minutes as well as adding and subtracting times.

### **In PE this half term, your child will be learning to ...**

- use and apply throwing and dribbling skills to take part in team and individual races;
- be able to interpret music and sequence together moves for a dance and gymnastics.
