Year Four's topic for this half term is...

Save the Forests!

This term your child's learning will be *Geography-based*, relating to the human and physical similarities and differences of areas of the world.



During this topic, we will be...

- learning to locate the world's continents and countries;
- learning to use eight points of a compass, grid references, symbols and keys;



- Comparing landscapes, climates, wildlife, population and other facts about the Amazon rainforest, coniferous forests in Scandinavia and Thetford forest.

In Literacy, this half term your child will be...

- writing newspaper reports, persuasive leaflets and posters ;
- developing the use of exciting and powerful vocabulary;
- focusing on the accuracy of punctuation and grammar in their writing;
- practising common spelling patterns.

In Maths, this half term your child will be learning and revising

- problem solving using the four operations;
- how to convert the measures of weight, length and capacity;
- equivalent fractions and decimals;

In PE, this half term your child will be;

- developing their accuracy and control when playing cricket and tennis;
- developing their skills of speed and agility.
